

Lifetime Service Award Criteria and Nomination Process

Award Description

The purpose of the *Lifetime Service Award* is to honor members who have made significant contributions to the field of institutional research and the professional development of INAIR members and colleagues. This award may recognize an individual retiring from the service of institutional research or who has made a substantial impact for at least ten years in total. Awardees will be honored annually at the INAIR spring conference.

Award Criteria

The nominee must have served at least one term on the INAIR executive board and meet two or more of the following criteria:

- Active and contributing member of INAIR
- Regularly participated in the annual conference as an attendee, presenter, or panelist
- Showed evidence of sustained contributions to the field of institutional research or service to INAIR, AIR, or affiliated organization
- Produced scholarly work advancing the field of institutional research
- Recognized as a leader among their peers

Nomination

A nomination letter from a current AIR member who can speak to the nominee's leadership and exemplary service to INAIR. The nomination should address two or more criteria specified above. Additionally, at least two letters of support must be included with the nomination.

Timeline

The call for nomination will go out in early February and close by March 3. The selection committee will meet in early March to review nominations and make their selection. The past president will inform nominees of their nomination status and that the winner will be announced at the INAIR Annual Conference Business Meeting.

Selection Committee

The past president will appoint an ad hoc committee representative of prior executive board members and/or past presidents. The past president will solicit nominations and convene the selection committee to review applications.
